

- In Vietnamese mythology, people are derived from the dragon. They have rong or long as a symbolic dragon creature.
- Dragons are very popular in China. The phoenix is a dragon that has five claws and was a symbol for the emperors in China. Chinese Dragons have 3 admired species and symbols of imperial power, namely Lung or Sky Dragon, Li or Sea Dragon and Kiau or Marsh Dragon.
- The Komodo Dragons from Indonesia are an aggressive and fatal type of lizard. They can grow as long as 10 feet in length and weigh more than 300 pounds, so it is referred to as the largest reptile. They have a mouth producing more than 50 toxic bacteria types, which they use to catch their prey. They are carnivores and even eat smaller dragons. But, when these smaller dragons hide in their poop, the bigger dragons do not eat them! This is also the reason why, after they are hatched, they stay in trees until they grow older.
- Another type of lizard and much smaller than a Komodo Dragon is the Flying Dragon or Draco Lizard, which can only grow up to 12 inches long. This lizard has flaps on both sides of the body which look like wings but serve as a glider. The Flying Dragons have stripes or spotted bright colors of red, blue or yellow. They stay in trees and eat insects. They are not poisonous, but many Asians think they are.
