Gather your crochet Eeyore pieces: Head, Hair, Body. Sew the head on the body. Make sure that you position the head towards the top of the body as shown in the picture above. Line up the head on the side of the body where you joined colors for the stripes (We are going to cover this part of the body with a crochet belly piece that is the same color as the muzzle. We will make this belly piece later.). Make sure that the Eeyore face is looking in the direction that you want it to; as you sew the head in place. If you need to pull the head, so that Eeyore looks upwards a little, sew it in place on the body to position the head correctly. **I would recommend sewing the head in place securely, because my experience is that children like to grab Eeyore by the hair and drag him around..lol...**
