Sew on the legs, then sew on the arms: **Place a little amount of craft stuffing in the center of the rectangle, before completely sewing it to the body. Sew along the edge, in the shape of a rectangle.**



Remember to check that the paws are facing up. Before sewing the arms and legs in place, make sure that you align them along Eeyore's side. Also check that you have the correct position for the legs, so that Eeyore is able to sit upright. I used the stripes on the body, to help line up the arms and legs.
